








The LNMC Logo

Makki who has a teaching experience of over 40 years and has been Chairman Department of Medicine Dow University of Health Sciences and is currently Head of Department of Medicine at LNH.

A large percentage of faculty members have been trained in USA & UK and are keen to make their contributions to the development of young professionals who would be the leaders of the future.

Central Amenities at LNMC

LIBRARY

The library has undergone major expansion and is housed within the Medical College. At LNMC, a substantial collection of more than 3000 medical EBooks and more than 8200 text books in print format are available on basic and clinical subjects and this is increased annually. The LNMC library is adequately staffed and is open from 08:30 am to 10:00 pm from Monday to Saturday.

LEARNING RESOURCE CENTRE

A Learning Resource Centre has been created which is fully computerized and comprising of internet equipped 100 stations to facilitate web based learning. Access to network computers is available to users (students and faculty) of this facility. It is linked to the Digital library (Courtesy of HEC) with access to a large number of text books and medical journals. There is an extensive collection of audiovisual material to augment learning in various basic and clinical sciences. The lectures conducted by the faculty are uploaded in the audio visual library of LNMC and are available on request.

Teaching aids such as Moodle are also utilized to implement e-learning. Additionally, students and faculty have internet access through Wi-Fi on their phones and laptops. They have also been provided with Apps such as Pharma guide on their phones which they can use in clinics and at home as well.

STUDENT CAFETERIA

A Cafeteria is located in the Centre of the campus on the ground floor of link building of the medical college, allowing easy access to faculty, staff and students. It provides healthy and tempting meals for visitors. A full lunch menu is also available at very subsidized rates. A new state of the art Cafeteria (Cafe Sukoon) is also functional to cater for Faculty, Staff, and Students & Visitors. Baithak an open air cafeteria that serves hot & cold beverages and snacks in a sophisticated ambiance.

BOOK SHOP

A book shop with a wide range of text and reference medical books of all disciplines of medicine is available within the premises of the Medical College. The book shop has all necessary stationery; equipment and Photostat facility for the students. Book Shop is also well equipped with gift items of wide choice of souvenirs.

ACADEMIC COUNCIL COMPLEX & DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CARE EDUCATION:

This complex has a large auditorium, several lecture theatres and a Hospitality Suite which are fully equipped with latest audiovisual facilities. The academic council complex also houses the Department of HealthCare Education (DHCE) to meet the changing need of the profession and ensure provision of quality education. LNMC has a (DHCE) which works closely with faculty to implement integrated curricula and design and undertakes reliable modular examinations. DHCE has developed study guides which facilitate both students and faculty. The department also undertakes faculty development program.

TEACHING FACILITIES

The Link Building has six Tutorial Rooms with computers and multimedia projectors and houses the administration office along with faculty offices. The old block houses five air-conditioned lecture halls equipped with all requisite audio visual aids and also has multiple air-conditioned labs, dissection hall and museums. The labs, museum and dissection hall are all as per PM&DC requirement and furnished with latest equipment's and have updated manuals and safety mechanisms in place.

ANIMAL HOUSE

Animal House at Liaquat National Hospital and Medical College has been established and is functional. An Animal keeper has been appointed to look after the animals. At present frogs, rats, mice, rabbits and guineapigs are available for the practical sessions of undergraduate students of LNMC.

The facility of animal house is to be utilized for initiating research projects based on animal studies by faculty and students. Faculty members are encouraged to start their research programs and utilize the animals. Other animals like sheep, kept for research projects are present at RSDC.

HOSTEL FACILITIES

Limited accommodation (subject to the availability of seats) is available on the premises for both male and female medical students from out of Karachi. Accommodation is provided on first come first facilitated bases.

TRANSPORT FACILITIES

The college has also arranged for transport facilities for students which ensure that they safely reach college on time.

Students Support Services

LNCM ADMINISTRATION

This office deals with a wide range of issues pertaining to a student's life at the campus such as coordinating admissions, examination accommodation financial matters, research and extra-curricular activities.

CAREER ADVISORY SERVICES

We at LNCM regard career building as an important responsibility. In addition to individual counseling the advisory service holds seminars and workshops to increase general awareness of the professional pathways available. It is extremely important that the students become fully aware of future prospects and career pathways. Unless the students possess the awareness and make timely decisions a great deal of time is wasted and the community loses the services of a talented professional.

MENTORSHIP

The Senior Faculty members of Liaquat National Hospital & Medical College (LNH&MC) are each assigned a small group of medical students for mentorship and counseling. The office hours indicating availability of faculty is provided to students who can meet or contact on phone or through e-mail in order to discuss any academic as well as non-academic or personal matters with their mentors. All mentors have been assigned 3 to 5 students.

Mentors are required to meet with the students and send their reports to the Principal on a regular basis.

Senior faculty of the medical college and hospital also mentors for extra-curricular activities and head student's Societies.

In addition to the mentors, the student is free to visit any faculty that they need help from. Junior faculty is often assigned to coach one to one weak students. Demonstrators and lecturers are also available to help them in small groups and lab sessions and they remain in close contact with the students to ensure smooth execution of teaching process.

CAREER FAIR

Regular career fairs are held to apprise students of possible career pathways in clinical and basic fields besides research, public health, pharmaceutical & insurance industry etc. Renowned personalities in respective fields are invited to provide career counseling to students. Students are also subsequently given opportunities to meet with the best in the field professionals and obtain career guidance on one to one basis.

SKILLS DEVELOPMENT CENTRE

Liaquat National Hospital has been taking a lead on national level in providing certifiable clinical and resuscitation skills training for almost fifteen years.

The department comprises of latest training equipment's as per international standards and has a trained certified dedicated team. The department has instrument rooms, interactive models and simulators. The participants are certified only after successfully getting through their assessments. This is a state of the art "ISO" certified department and provide high quality of trainings including; American Heart Association (AHA) accredited Basic Life Support and Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support, Heart Saver First Aid, Advanced Airway Management, Basic Interpretation of ECG, Emergency

Response Skills, Basic Surgical Skills and Basic Nursing Skills and many more.

RESEARCH

LNMC students are taught research & facilitated in conduct of research they develop protocols which are reviewed by faculty. All the protocols are then assessed by research committees, which comprises of Chairperson and 8 – 10 members. The research committee has developed its own guidelines for submission of research projects meeting the international Helsinki Guidelines. Once the research protocol along with the budget & time line is approved then it is referred to ethical review for final approval. Research committee has substantial funds and encourages students & faculty to participate in national or international conferences and submit articles to international & national journals and provides financial support. Additionally the college also has a research society which holds lectures and research expo. To date our Medical students have published multiple papers in local and international journals as well as read papers both locally as well as internationally.

STUDENT RESEARCH

Liaquat National Hospital & Medical College (LNH&MC) encourages research activities of students and faculty members and the subject is extensively taught to students and culminates in protocol development. To further inculcate the importance of research LNMC has a research committee of students too.

Awards & Scholarships

1. MERIT SCHOLARSHIP:

Students securing highest marks in first to fourth professional MBBS examinations of University are awarded cash award as per policy according to following scheme:

- i. For First Position Rs. 125,000/-
- ii. For Second Position Rs. 100,000/-
- iii. For Third Position Rs. 75,000/-

Students securing highest marks in final professional MBBS examination are awarded cash award as per policy according to following scheme:

- i. For overall best Graduate Rs 400,000/-
- ii. For First Position Rs. 250,000/-
- iii. For Second Position Rs. 200,000/-
- iv. For Third Position Rs. 150,000/-

2. NEED BASED SCHOLARSHIP:

Liaquat National Medical College (LNMC) awards Need Based Scholarship every year to deserving students.

PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING NEED BASED SCHOLARSHIP:

- Need Based Scholarship is announced every year for all students through a circular disseminated via email and displayed on noticed boards
- Students of all classes are required to submit his/her application in prescribed format within a period of one month from the announcement date.
- Deserving students can apply each year for Need Based scholarship.
- The decision on numbers and amount of scholarship per class is made by a committee comprising of competent authority of LNMC considering the financial needs of students and their decision is final.
- The process is concluded after the evaluation of all applications received from the students and interview process of candidates.
- Finally, the allocated amount is communicated to the students via official letter from the competent authority by stating amount and class in which a student gets scholarship.
- The student needs to perform satisfactorily in academics and maintain discipline else the scholarship may be withdrawn.

CURRICULUM

Liaquat National Medical College has implemented system-based integrated Spiral Curriculum that ensures alignment with the guidelines of the Jinnah Sindh Medical University and PM&DC. In Spiral Curriculum, students have opportunities to revisit several times segments of learning throughout their five years of education. Student learning begins with fundamental concepts and with progression to each new phase students build new concepts with increasing complexities based on previous learning.

This helps student to make links between concepts and application of knowledge with understanding. In this curriculum, students learn through organ-based modules which integrate basic sciences knowledge to clinical problems. For example, Cardiovascular system is introduced in MBBS first year and revisited in MBBS third year.

The focus of MBBS first year is more on normal and abnormal structures and functions of the cardiovascular system, while in third it focuses on common clinical presentations along with diagnosis, relevant investigations, and prevention of diseases. Exposure to clinics and hospital wards is also embedded in modular teaching.

For MBBS First year, a structured Study Skills course is offered for students to cope with academic stress encountered in medical studies.

A longitudinal course comprising research, communication skills, patient safety, professionalism and ethics shall be integrated in the spiral curriculum.

Islamiyat and Pakistan studies too form part of the curriculum.

STUDY GUIDE

LNH&MC has developed modular study guides to help students plan their studies in accordance with the objectives and teaching activities. The study guide informs students on the outcomes and objectives to be achieved through multiple disciplines, learning experiences and use of recommended learning resources for self- study. In addition, study guide provides information on different assessment methods and examination rules that help students prepare for examinations.

EXAMINATION RULES AND REGULATIONS

- **Jinnah Sindh Medical University (JSMU):**

LNH&MC is affiliated with the JSMU which conducts the MBBS annual & Retake Professional examinations for all five years of education.

Every academic year comprises modules and that may constitute up to eight modules.

EXAMINATION RULES & REGULATIONS SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS

- JSMU schedules Annual examinations on completion of academic year.
- Annual examination carries 80% weightage.
- Internal evaluation carries 20% marks in JSMU examination.

INTERNAL EVALUATION

- LNMC is responsible for internal evaluation of MBBS students.
- Medical students are assessed continuously throughout every module by multiple methods such as module exam, OSPE, quizzes, assignments, presentations or tutorials which are mandatory to attempt.
- Students not sitting for module exam are not allowed to sit for Midterm and Pre prof.
- Mid-term and pre professional examinations comprising of Theory and Practical / Clinical Examinations are held in the middle and end of the academic year respectively
- MBBS Students' aggregated scores in mid-term and pre-professional examinations are submitted to JSMU annually
- The marks attained in every defined aspect are compiled and the final internal evaluation will constitutes 20% of weightage which is submitted to JSMU.
- Each theory paper comprises of one best type MCQs
- Clinical examinations are Objective Structured Practical or Clinical Examinations (OSPE/OSCE) format.

1. JSMU GRADING SYSTEM

- Based on GPA – 4 system
- A candidate obtaining GPA less than 2.00 (50%) is declared un-graded (fail).

2. JSMU ANNUAL EXAMINATIONS

- JSMU schedules annual examination on completion of medical studies of every year of MBBS education

3. RETAKE EXAMINATION

- JSMU conducts Retake examination for students failing annual examinations.

MBBS Admission Policy for Session 2023 - 24

MBBS Admission Policy for Session 2023 – 24 (Class of 2029)

LNMC will open admission portal for MBBS Session 2023-24 after the announcement of MDCAT results.

ADMISSION ON LOCAL SEATS:

As per PM&DC regulation dated 13th July 2023, to be eligible for admission at Liaquat National Medical College, a candidate must have:

- Passed the MDCAT examination (55% and above);
- Obtained a Higher Secondary School certificate qualification ("HSSC") or an equivalent 12th grade qualification recognized in Pakistan and having obtained a minimum of sixty percent (60%) marks therein, or a higher percentage as may be notified by the Pakistan Medical and Dental Council; and
- Passed the mandatory subjects of biology and chemistry. The student may opt to qualify either physics or mathematics in the examination of the Higher Secondary School Certificate or an equivalent 12th grade qualification recognized in Pakistan.

ADMISSION ON FOREIGN / DUAL NATIONAL / OVERSEAS PAKISTANI QUOTA SEATS

As per PM&DC regulation dated 13th July 2023, the student admitted against foreign / Dual National /overseas Pakistani quota shall have to fulfill the following admission criteria:

- A foreign quota seat candidate should hold a permanent foreign nationality or be an overseas (being a Pakistani citizen permanently resident in a foreign country) Pakistani, and who has studied and passed HSSC 12th grade examination or equivalent from outside Pakistan and is a resident of a foreign country at the time of applying for admission and possess a certificate from the institution last attended to this effect. The student must pass the mandatory subjects of biology and chemistry and may opt to qualify either physics or mathematics in the examination of the Higher Secondary School Certificate or an equivalent 12th grade qualification recognized in Pakistan.
- The mandatory requirement of MDCAT shall not apply to students seeking admission on a special program seat predefined exclusively for foreign students and on the seats reserved for overseas Pakistanis. Such students shall qualify SAT-II with minimum score of 550 in each subject or a foreign MCAT examination or UCAT examination with 50% marks in the subjects mentioned above.
- Provided further that a student admitted on a foreign seat shall pay the fee as a foreign student regardless of any change in status of such student during the program of study. A foreign student shall pay the prescribed fee in foreign exchange only.

WEIGHTAGE SCHEME FOR PREPARATION OF MERIT LIST

The following PM&DC policy will be followed for admission of 1st year session 2023-24, according to the PM&DC regulation dated 13th July 2023.

- MDCAT (50%)
- F. Sc. (Pre-Medical) / HSSC / Equivalent (40%) of total marks and
- SSC/Matriculation/Equivalent (10%) of total marks

ADMISSION PROCESS

- The admission process shall be conducted through an online admission portal.
- Applicant shall pay the Application Registration Fee (Rs. 2,000) by printing voucher from the portal, depositing payment in bank and uploading the receipt in the portal.
- LNMC shall issue provisional and final merit lists of all students on its official website taking into account results of MDCAT and other exam results.
- A student when accepting admission to our college shall be under an obligation to disclose if a prior admission has been accepted by him/her to any other college, and such student shall prior to accepting such latter admission must in writing inform the prior college of cancellation of their acceptance with a copy to the designated email to PM&DC & LNMC.
- If any student declines admission offer or does not pay fee by voucher due date, next applicant on the merit list will be offered admission against such seat.
- The final list of admitted students shall be submitted to PM&DC through PM&DC Online Portal.

Another section is involved in disseminating time table, circulars, notices related to classes and ward rotations, examination and electives and making necessary arrangements for the same.



Anatomy

INTRODUCTION

The subject of Anatomy is one of the core basic science subjects. The Department of Anatomy was established in the year 2006 as one of the basic science department along with the establishment of the Medical College. The department runs the undergraduate integrated medical curriculum of JSMU and other medical allied programs.

SERVICES

The department has as spacious air-conditioned dissection hall with a facility for cadaveric dissection. The air conditioned museum has ample number of plastic models of Gross anatomy, embryology, neuroanatomy and other related structures of the body. The department also has a large collection of original prospected specimens and a bone bank.

The histology lab is equipped with the latest multi headed and binocular microscopes with sufficient numbers of slides of various tissues and organs. Fully developed multimedia along with CCTV for the students to observe slides through LED monitors is also therefor teaching purpose.

UNDERGRADUATE TEACHING

The department comprises of highly experienced senior Professor and highly trained faculty members. The teaching methodology adopted is a combination of newer learning methods like Self-Directed Learning, Large Group Interactive Sessions (LGIS), Small Group Discussions (SGD), Case-based learning (CBL), Team based learning (TBL), flipped classroom, hands on training and human cadaveric dissections. Regular formative assessments are conducted in the form of MCQs and OSPEs. Students are regularly provided feedback regarding their academic progress. This helps the students to achieve excellence in their exams.

POST-GRADUATE TEACHING

Liaquat National Hospital and Medical College is also recognized by CPSP for FCPS in the subject of Anatomy.

RESEARCH & FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM:

Forensic Medicine

The Department of Forensic Medicine is responsible for teaching forensic medicine and toxicology and ethics at the undergraduate level according to the latest MBBS curriculum prescribed by Pakistan Medical & Dental Council.

The main objective is to highlight those legal aspects of medical practice which future doctors will be expected to apply knowledge and skill in dealing with medico-legal matters / issues when required by the court of law and professional medical practice.

SERVICES

This department is well equipped with offices, lecture hall, tutorial room, demonstrator office, serology lab and museum having all types of models and artificial weapons and other facilities for teaching, presentations, discussion and practical training of students, thus imparting the required and up-to-date knowledge.

UNDERGRADUATE EDUCATION

Students are taught about different aspects of forensic medicine which includes Law in relation to medical profession, medical ethics, informed consent, medical negligence, certification of cause of death, medico legal autopsy, recognition and interpretation of mechanical injuries, burn injuries, traffic accidents, deaths from asphyxia, domestic violence, medico legal aspects relating to sexual assault, medico-legal aspects of marriage, pregnancy & delivery, forensic aspects of personal identification, Biometrics, Polygraph, age certification, torture and death in custody, forensic psychiatry, forensic examination of biological fluids, blood & semen stains, trace evidence. In addition to these, the forensic toxicology relevant to diagnosis, identification of poison, management and treatment are part of curriculum. The student learning program has been integrated according to module wise studies. The learning methods used are: Interactive lectures, demonstration, tutorials making use of multimedia. For practical orientation, the students visit ER, Mortuary and National poisoning control center of Pakistan for Medico Legal cases. Students have to be assessed at by the affiliated University accordingly.

Online examinations are also conducted at LNMC using Moodle as a resource. This enables secure and fair assessment delivery which enhances the efficiency, accuracy, and effectiveness of assessments at LNMC

Pathology

The clinical lab is ISO 9001: 2008 certified and participates in EQA programs by College of American Pathologists, to assure quality. Equipped with high-tech latest equipment's and qualified experienced staff, it handles more than a million specimens every year and works round the clock.

Qualified teaching faculty with vast experience and training, for each sub specialty is present. Continuous assessment of the students is performed at regular intervals and a close eye is kept on their performance throughout the year.

RESEARCH

Research is actively encouraged and conducted with participation in national & international conferences, paper presentations as well as publications in reputable local and international journals. Postgraduate training is an integral part of the department, and so far more than 40 trainees have cleared their FCPS in various disciplines of Pathology.

The Department of Emergency at Liaquat National Hospital is providing a variety of services to its patients. Having all the facilities of any modern tertiary care hospital. It is more than capable to deal with every type of medical, surgical and trauma related emergency.

SERVICES

The Department provides services by Consultants, Senior Registrars, Registrars and Medical officers round the clock, dealing with all types of major and life threatening emergencies with expertise and dedication.

Our mission is to provide quality emergency care to the patients in a friendly yet professional environment.

The Department is staffed with skillful doctors, nurses and dedicated team of ancillary services. It has all kinds of investigations and treatment facilities available, under one roof.

Our departmental layout consists of Acute, isolation area, Male and Female bays, divided according to patient condition based on Triage. We are supported by a wide range of services, including round-the-clock Cardiac Catheterization, Radiology, Laboratory as well as Minor Procedure facilities. The emergency patients have the services of all specialty doctors present in the hospital.

We also offer dressings and stitching of the wounds, fixation of fractures, in our minor Procedure room at all times of the day.

UNDERGRADUATE AND POSTGRADUATE TEACHING

The Department has a regular teaching program for under and post graduate students and provides a chance for hands-on training in acute management of critically ill patients.

RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

The Emergency Department has multiple ongoing research projects with the aim of producing local data that will be beneficial in better patient management.

ACHIEVEMENTS

The Emergency Department has always rendered its services with complete dedication and expertise during times of disaster in the city and prides itself in saving many lives, under adverse circumstances.

Department is now recognized by CPSP for Emergency Medicine training. The departmental is also ISO certified 9001: 2015. The department had been a part of hospital Covid team and handled patient effectively in pandemic situation with training and teaching of doctors and staff according to infection control policy for Covid19 patients.



Anesthesiology

INTRODUCTION

The Anesthesiology, Critical Care, and Pain Management Department provide high-quality, evidence-based care for a wide range of surgical, diagnostic, and interventional procedures. For a significant number of patients, our faculty delivers safe and efficient non-operating room anesthesia (NORA) care at pediatric cardiac Cath lab, adult Cath lab, CT, and MRI suites, ultrasound procedures room, lithotripsy, and endoscopy suite. The faculty has extensive perioperative medicine experience, expertise in airway management, intravascular access, resuscitation, management of critically ill patients, and acute and chronic pain treatment. Throughout the year, a large number of high-risk challenging patients successfully undergo complex surgical procedures.

SERVICES

- **Anaesthesia clinic:** The Anaesthesia clinic provides evaluation and treatment plans to ensure that patients are managed well during their perioperative phase. Our objectives are to reduce perioperative risk by utilizing evidence-based best-practice preoperative evaluation and treatment. Preoperatively, all patients who are scheduled to receive anesthesia are screened for co-morbid disorders that enhance perioperative risk preoperative interventions are initiated to minimize the risk of complications. Patients are educated to optimize their perioperative care and reduce post-operative complications, particularly pulmonary complications.
- The department has state-of-the-art operating rooms equipped with modern anesthesia workstations, facilities for invasive monitoring, advanced airway management (video-laryngoscopy, fiberoptic bronchoscopy), monitoring for depth of anesthesia and quantitative neuromuscular monitoring caters to different anesthetic requirements for general surgery, orthopedics, urology, vascular, otolaryngology, head & neck, pediatrics, plastic and reconstructive, faciomaxillary, thoracic, cardiac (both adult and pediatric), neurosurgery, obstetrics & gynecology, and trauma surgery.
- **Post-anaesthesia care unit (PACU):** All patients are admitted to PACU following anesthesia and surgery where they are managed until they regain full consciousness, and their postoperative nausea and vomiting (PONV) and postoperative pain are under control. Patients are not discharged until vital signs have stabilized and PONV and pain are under control. The PACU is manned by trained and skilled staff who continue the same monitoring that was being carried out in the operating room.
- A multidisciplinary team made up of intensivist (members of our faculty), surgeons, other consultants, trained ICU nurses, pharmacists, and physical therapists manages medical and surgical critically ill patients, round-the-clock in surgical intensive care units that are provided with state-of-the-art equipment.
- Our Acute Pain Service team is dedicated to minimizing postoperative pain and assisting with early ambulation and rehabilitation of surgical patients. Our specifically trained faculty members with perioperative pain management expertise, anesthesia residents, and a pain nurse make up the team. In order to minimize postoperative pain, the acute pain team employs a multimodal strategy that includes combinations of various drugs, epidurals, ultrasound-guided peripheral nerve blocks, epidurals and state-of-the-art patient-controlled analgesia (PCA) pumps.

- **Chronic Pain Clinic:** Pain is a complicated and often debilitating medical condition that can have a major impact on quality of life, physical function and mental well-being. Our pain specialists offer a comprehensive range of treatments for patients with chronic pain including epidurals, facet joint injections, peripheral nerve blocks, lumbar & stellate ganglion blocks and celiac plexus block for conditions like backache, cancer pain, ischemic limb pain, complex regional pain syndromes, neuralgias and neuropathic pain.

UNDERGRADUATE TEACHING

Our faculty members regularly teach undergraduate and postgraduate students. Regular lectures are scheduled for final year students and they are rotated in our department as part of their training.

RESEARCH

Faculty and residents present papers both in national and international conferences of anesthesia from time to time. CMEs, workshops and public awareness programs are also arranged periodically. Research is also conducted on various topics by trainee residents supervised by seven supervisors in the department. Students are also encouraged to do research.

ACHIEVEMENTS

- We run a structured residency program, for FCPS in Anesthesiology. To date, our 125 trainee (MCPS, FCPS) have successfully passed their exams after completing the training who are now serving different hospitals of the country as well as abroad.

Cardiac Surgery

INTRODUCTION

The Department offers a very high standard of diagnostic and therapeutic facilities. It is recognized as one of the premier centers for treatment of Cardiac surgery diseases and ailments in the city. All types of adult and pediatric Cardiac surgery procedures are performed here. The department has performed a large number of complicated and complex heart operations. On an average over 500 procedures are performed annually.

SERVICES

In addition onsite, laboratory, blood bank, Angiography, Echocardiography, Exercise tolerance testing (ETT), Thallium stress test, CT scanning, MRI, Carotid Doppler, Dialysis, ultrasound, diabetic care and physiotherapy services round the clock which not only saves the patient and their families from running around but at the same time speaks of the multi specialization structure of the hospital and make this unit a very safe place for all sort of Cardiac Surgery procedures.

UNDERGRADUATE AND POSTGRADUATE TEACHING

The department is recognized for training by the College of Physician and Surgeons Pakistan (CPSP) for postgraduate trainees. The students of LNMC rotate through this department as well. During their stay along with bed side teaching, they are encouraged to attend OT to witness bypass and Mitral / Aortic Valve replacement operations.

RESEARCH

The department encourages research and has published various papers in PM&DC recognized journals.

The department of Cardiology is providing best Cardiac Services to our people. Not only people of Pakistan but also people from adjoining Countries also visited and take advantage of the best Service provided in our department. The department has wide range of Cardiac related facilities which meet the requirement of our patients.

FACULTY



The department of Cardiology has adequate number of faculty members. The faculty includes both invasive and non-invasive Cardiologist. Beside this, Adult Congenital Heart disease Specialist is also a part of faculty. Along with Adult Cardiology Services, our hospital also provide Paediatric Cardiology Services with full time dedicated Cardiologist and Cardiac Surgeon. Adult Cardiac Surgery is available in our hospital with full time dedicated Cardiac Surgeon.

FACILITIES

24 hour emergency service for Cardiac patients is available in our emergency department without any break. From Monday to Saturday, Cardiac OPD service is available in both morning and afternoon shifting. Evening executive OPD is also available most of the days. We have the best Coronary Angiography machine in our Cath Lab. We provide the best coronary angiography and angioplasty (PCI) services to our patients. Temporary and Permanent pacemaker are implanted in our Cath Lab. Paediatric and Adult Congenital Heart Disease procedures are performed here. For our emergency patients, we provide 24 hour services of Coronary Angiogram, PCI and Cardiac Surgery. Our non-invasive department is equipped with high quality echocardiography machines, ETT services, 24 to 72 hours Holter Monitoring, Ambulatory BP pressure recording, Tilt Table Test and Myocardial perfusion scan (MPS). Our echo department perform high quality echocardiogram, and other echo related procedure like Dobutamine Stress Echo (DSE), Transesophageal echo (TEE) and perform Pericardiocentesis.

CARDIOLOGY TRAINING

The department of Cardiology is recognized by College of Physician and Surgeon of Pakistan (CPSP) for post graduate training. A large number of doctors have successfully passed the FCPS and providing the best services in the different hospitals. Our department provides best training environment for both undergraduate and postgraduate students.



Dermatology

INTRODUCTION

Department of Dermatology, Liaquat National Hospital & Medical College comprises of three out patients clinics, which are being run on daily basis. The morning clinic is without appointment for any walk in patients while the afternoon clinic is an appointment clinic. Patients are referred from dermatology reviewed from all other departments of the hospital.

SERVICES

The Department is offering certain essential procedures for better services i.e. intralesional steroids injection for Keloid, Alopecia Areata. Elector cautery for viral warts. Cryo therapy or liquid nitrogen gas spray is used for viral Infections like Molluscum Contagiosum and warts. Chemical cautery with the help of trichloro acetic acid touches for Xanthelasma Patients, PRP for all types of Alopecia and Acne scars. UVB and UVA for many skin conditions like Psoriasis, Vitiligo, Atopic Dermatitis and cutaneous Malignancies.


LNH also offering Aesthetics procedure like PRP, Microneedling, Laser Hydro-facial, skin Rejuvenation, Skin peels, etc.

- Rotation of undergraduate students for two weeks in dermatology department and their theory and practical exam at the end of the rotation.
- Conduction of module of dermatology of fourth year students of medical college.
- Clinical teaching in the outpatients department.

RESEARCH

The Department understands the importance of research and provision of local data and is actively involved in research activities.



Diabetes, Endocrinology & Metabolism

INTRODUCTION

Endocrinology is rapidly growing specialty worldwide. The Endocrine System consists of a collection of glands that control basic body functions such as metabolism of sugars, fats and proteins. Endocrinology encompasses wide medical disorders including diabetes mellitus, lipid disorders, obesity, hypertension, pituitary disorders, thyroid and parathyroid disorders, adrenal (cortisol deficiencies and excess), diabetes insipidus and inappropriate release of vasopressin, associated with thirst disorders and electrolyte imbalance (abnormal sodium and other electrolytes), problems of puberty, calcium and bone disorders (osteoporosis, osteomalacia, Vitamin D disorders), growth disorders (short stature, abnormal growth including acromegaly), female hormonal issues (menopause, Hormone Replacement Therapy, Polycystic Ovarian Syndrome), gonadal and reproductive disorders including male infertility.

SERVICES

With the help of specialized diabetes educationist and dedicated nutritionists, all patients are provided with diabetes education and a diet plan tailored to their needs and capacities. General endocrine clinics are held daily in the morning and afternoon. Specialized clinics are also held for Obesity, Growth, Gestational Diabetes and Thyroid disorders.

There are three full time Consultants (Dr Aqiba Sarfraz, MBBS, MCPS, FCPS (Head of Department), Dr Ali Asghar, MBBS, MRCP (UK), FACE (USA) and Dr Muhammad Owais Rashid, MBBS, FCPS (Medicine), FCPS (Endocrinology) in the department.

UNDERGRADUATE & POSTGRADUATE TEACHING

The department is actively involved in under-graduate and post-graduate training including lectures, CME activities, clinical and bedside teaching.



E.N.T / Head & Neck Surgery

INTRODUCTION

The Department of ENT Head & Neck Surgery is a major tertiary referral unit in Pakistan. We have highly qualified consultants and trained junior staff. Emphasis is on providing quality care to our patients. We deal with full range of ENT disease including head & neck cancer.

SERVICES

The ENT ward is staffed by trained personnel. The ward comprises of semi-private/ private rooms. We provide outpatient services six days a week.

Patients with ENT problems are managed in a planned and coordinated manner for quick establishment of diagnosis and early treatment. We work in coordination with medical and radiation oncologist, reconstructive surgeon and pathologist to formulate a multi-disciplinary comprehensive management plan for our oncology patients.

Our services cover a wide spectrum of ENT, salivary glands Head & Neck cancer surgeries. We have started neonatal hearing screening of all the babies born at Liaquat National Hospital. This is the first services of its kind in Pakistan. We also provide audiology services by a trained audiology technician.

UNDERGRADUATE TRAINING

The ENT faculty is highly focused and motivated in providing excellent undergraduate teaching. The goal is to train our medical students is to make medical students- responsible, dedicated, competent and caring doctors. The department encourages students to participate in research and academic activities.

We have four weeks and six week rotation in 3rd and 4th year respectively, during that we make student understand the basic of diagnostic and therapeutic tools to diagnose ENT related disease. We conduct interactive assessment at the end of their rotation

RESEARCH

The Department is keenly interested in Research activities.



Family Medicine

INTRODUCTION

The Department of Family Medicine was established in March 2016, is recognized for its comprehensive, accessible and affordable primary health care services.

SERVICES

Our team of consultants and Family physicians practice a bio-psycho-social model of care and provide holistic health care to patients. In addition, to educate our patients on disease prevention, our doctors perform risk assessments and screening tests for early identification of diseases. We deal with a wide range of medical problems, acute as well as chronic illnesses encountered by adults, women, children, and the elderly population. The scope of our services follows the "hub and scope model," with clinical facilities located at the main hospital campus, senior citizens' primary care unit, employee health clinic, and outreach medical services located at five different locations in Karachi, including Shah Faisal Colony, Gulistan-e-Jauhar, Gulshan-e-Iqbal, Nazimabad, and Naseerabad. In addition, through home visits, Our Family physicians make health care more accessible to those patients who cannot visit our clinics, especially the elderly and bed-bound patients suffering from chronic diseases or disabilities.

UNDERGRADUATE TEACHING

The family Medicine department places great emphasis on teaching and training medical students. Students' clinical rotations are organized to develop an understanding of the principles of Family Medicine and primary care. Through our faculty role modeling, students learn to apply the bio-psycho-social model, continuity of care, empathy, and compassion to manage their patients. We strive to prepare our medical graduates to effectively deal with common medical problems encountered at the primary care level in the community.

POST GRADUATE TRAINING

The College of Physicians and Surgeons Pakistan recognizes the department for FCPS and MCPS training in Family Medicine. Our fellowship training aims to prepare Primary care specialists and academic leaders who can offer the community comprehensive, cost-effective preventive, curative, and rehabilitative care. In collaboration with World Health Organization the department is offering a one-year postgraduate certificate program in Family Medicine. This program provides practicing GPs with a unique opportunity for continuous professional development through a flexible hybrid learning environment.

RESEARCH

Department of Family Medicine promotes a culture of research and evidence-based practice in primary care. Our faculty is involved in many research projects and contribute as a member of the editorial board for Liaquat National journal of primary care, which is indexed at Google Scholar, Dimensions-Digital Science (UK), CORE (UK), and Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ) and recognized by the Higher Education Commission Pakistan (HEC).



Gastroenterology

INTRODUCTION

The Department of Gastroenterology is housed in the Syed Wajid Ali Shah Complex of LNH. The department has seven full time faculty members and a Senior Registrar.

SERVICES

It comprises of dedicated ward providing in-patient care. There are 10 dedicated OPD rooms which are run by the highly qualified consultants on daily basis in which any patient with liver or gastrointestinal problems may walk in with and / or without prior appointment.

Our Endoscopy Suite has four rooms with state of the art equipment's. It provides facilities for broad range of diagnostic and therapeutic procedures including Esophago Gastro Duodenoscopy (upper GI endoscopy), Colonoscopy (lower GI endoscopy) and Endoscopic Retrograde Cholangio Pancreatography (ERCP). We have our own fluoroscopy in the endoscopy suite.

We also have Endoscopic Ultrasound facility available. We have dedicated women endoscopy services also. State of art Fibroscan machine available in OPD. UBT (Urea breath test) for Hpylori detection in also available in OPD.

UNDERGRADUATE AND POSTGRADUATE EDUCATION

Apart from clinical services a lot of focus is on academic and research activity. The department has full recognition from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Pakistan for three years fellowship program in gastroenterology and the selection process is highly competitive. LNH is one of the largest Gastroenterology training centers in Pakistan.

The Students of Liaquat National Medical College regularly rotate with each faculty for two weeks. During their rotation, they attend OPDs do ward rounds with consultants and observe and interpret endoscopic findings.

At the end of their rotation, assessment of students is done through MCQs based test. Their attendance and assessment marks are marked on regular basis and signed by the faculty responsible.

ACHIEVEMENTS

It is an honor of our department that our trained fellows are accomplished gastroenterologist and are working in the different hospital in Pakistan and abroad.

Residents & students are actively involved in research projects, which are published and presented nationally and internationally.



General Medicine

INTRODUCTION

The Department of Medicine is the main department of LNH&MC, which provide the basic services to all the patients with medical problems.

We conduct daily outpatient clinics (more than 24 thousand patients visit annually), where the patients are given due attention and they are investigated for proper management. We also provide medical care to inpatients, either in low cost male and female wards, special wards or executive wards with good nursing care. Patients requiring intensive care are admitted to a fully equipped intensive care unit (MICU), where a patient has access to all necessary investigation and treatment required in a critical setup.

We have introduced Geriatric services for elderly population of 65 years and above. These services are based on initial evaluation, screening for neurocognitive deficit, psychological advice and physiotherapy evaluation. We are also providing home visits in collaboration with home health services department.

UNDERGRADUATE TEACHING

The Department's goal is "to prepare outstanding doctors, create and disseminate Knowledge, and integrate the values of this divine profession of medicine". It undertakes regular teaching and training and assessment to achieve these objectives. 3rd year, 4th year & final year MBBS students are trained by lectures, tutorials, bed side teaching, clinical discussions. They are rotated in OPDs, Medical & Allied subjects wards for training. This department is recognized by the PM&DC for house job training to fresh graduates.

It plays a vital role in the training of under & postgraduate trainees under supervision of highly qualified faculty. The Department's postgraduate training is highly appreciated within the country by the postgraduate trainees and the department also facilitates the candidates who are appearing in IMM medicine and FCPS II Medicine examinations by conducting hands on workshops. The department is approved by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Pakistan (CPSP) as well as by Royal College of Physicians for FCPS & MRCP training for four years.

RESEARCH

The department regularly arranges research activities and workshops to encourage students to do research and publish.



General Surgery

INTRODUCTION

Serving the community for half a century, the Department of General Surgery is committed to impart high quality service to its clientele. With over 5000 surgical procedures/year, we form a vigorous workforce ensuring the delivery of comprehensive surgical care.

UNDERGRADUATE TEACHING AND TRAINING

The highly trained full time faculty is totally committed to provide undergraduate education. From the inception of the medical school till the implementation of the integrated modular system the Surgery department is deeply involved in student's academic development. From large lectures to small tutorial groups the students are intensely tutored and receive individual attention. During their clinical rotation, they are attached to faculty members who take great interest in sharpening their clinical acumen, enhancing analytical skills, organizing tests and arranging feedback sessions. Students exposure to the clinical environment is strengthened by the large volume and variety of patients managed by the highly skilled faculty in the state of the art way. They are nurtured to become competent professionals. The department is also involved in Postgraduate Teaching and Training.

RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

The Department of General Surgery actively participates in research activities related to general surgery, breast surgery and medical education. So far, department has produced multiple good quality publications and many are in the pipeline. The students are encouraged by faculty members to enroll in supporting research projects in order to develop their research acumen.

ACHIEVEMENTS

The department is the forerunner and the hub of educational activities for the entire hospital. Multiple medical education workshops are regularly conducted by the faculty to train the hospital faculty to impart quality education. In addition symposia with local and foreign speakers, workshops and CMEs are a regular feature.



Nephrology

INTRODUCTION

The Division of Nephrology and Hypertension cares for patients with a diverse range of kidney diseases through inpatient consult service, ward/transplant service, outpatient clinics and hemodialysis facilities. It has gained recognition for its expertise in difficult to manage and complicated cases.

SERVICES

Nephrology ward includes a separate male ward, female ward and private wing. The department has its own intensive care unit with ventilator support and separate step down unit. 24 hours emergency care is provided to all the patients.

HAEMODIALYSIS UNIT

The Department of Nephrology comprises of a separate unit of Hemodialysis, which provides round the clock service, seven days a week for chronic hemodialysis as well as acute emergency dialysis. Dialysis unit is staffed with well-trained nurses and technicians. There are dedicated units for hepatitis B & C positive patients. Peritoneal dialysis is also offered in our unit.

ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

Educational activities in the division, ranges from teaching medical students to providing advanced training for fellows. The Renal Fellowship Program is aggregated with CPSP and is comprised of comprehensive training program that covers all” aspects of clinical nephrology and actively involves the fellows in research. The division’s faculty also provide core curriculum to residents and students, and participate in continuing medical education (CME) programs sponsored by Liaquat National Hospital & Medical College. By the grace of Allah 37 nephrology fellows have completed their training up till now and 23 fellows have achieved the success in FCPS part II nephrology exam and awarded the FCPS nephrology degree.

Morning rounds are conducted daily, which includes bedside clinical teaching, case discussion and nephrology updates and topic reviews. There is monthly morbidity and mortality meeting, which reinforce better patient service. We have arrange monthly PSN meeting in which all nephrology hospital participate actively.

RESEARCH

Research activities are mandatory and are supervised by Head of the Department. There has been multiple research papers published and multiple ongoing projects in progress by the faculty of Nephrology.



Neurology

INTRODUCTION

The Neurology Department of Liaquat National Hospital runs outpatient clinics and also has a fully equipped Neurophysiology laboratory which performs nerve conduction studies and electromyography (NCS/EMG), electroencephalogram (EEG) and evoked potentials (EPs).

SERVICES

The outpatient department provides clinic run by consultants and his team of residents and medical officers. All the patients visiting the clinic are seen by the consultants personally.

The inpatient services include a stroke unit which is a high dependency unit which caters for patients with acute neurological problems.

Neurology department is staffed with five qualified neurology consultants who are actively involved in patients care and academic activities.

A team of highly qualified neurologists, internist, medical officers, electrophysiology technologists and nurses are available and fully dedicated to the mission of the department.

UNDERGRADUATE TEACHING

Undergraduate teaching is in the form of regular bedside teaching sessions and didactic class's lectures of 3rd year, 4th year & 5th year as per guidelines of PM&DC. Regular assessments of all 3 clinical years are done on regular basis at the end of their posting. Undergraduate students keep records in log books, log cards, journal & grade book.

Teaching sessions are also conducted regularly for neurology residents and medicine residents rotating through Neurology.

CMEs are conducted from time to time for of general physicians and the public.

RESEARCH

Realizing its importance the department is involved in propagating scientific research and publications and actively participate in national and local conferences.



Neurosurgery

INTRODUCTION

The Department of Neurosurgery is a state of art department for the surgical and non- surgical evaluation, treatment and training of the full range of adult nervous system diseases. The Neurosurgery Department provides most advance specialized patient care in a compassionate and accommodating manner.

SERVICES

The Neurosurgery department is the busiest and technologically advanced unit with the high patient flow. We have morning, afternoon and evening OPDs with two Neurosurgical operation theaters that are available 24/7. The department has high dependency unit beds and isolation room There are 8 Neuro-Spinal surgeons in this department, backed by a team of experienced neuroradiologists, intensivist, and neurophysicians. The highly advanced imaging and technical facilities at Liaquat National Hospital allow for a very successful outcome of surgery.

UNDERGRADUATE AND POSTGRADUATE TEACHING

The Department of Neurosurgery has organized various CME's, public awareness programs and cadaver courses on various topics including spine, Image guidance, Endoscopy, Neuro-Anatomy and skull base surgery. We have also organized and conducted more than 250 webinars on operative neurosurgery, basic and advance neurosurgery, Neuro-Endoscopy and Neuro-Anatomy.

We are teaching undergraduate with didactic lectures and tutorials. We encompass clinical electives for medical students from all over Pakistan to experience and indulge the state of the art facilities neurosurgery offers at LNH&MC. Due to the growing interest of young doctors in neurosurgery, we have established a "Pakistan Neurosurgery Students Society" that provides a platform for medical students to engage with us and stay inspired.

RESEARCH

The Department is involved in research activities. We have publications in renowned neurosurgical journal. Department has separate fund to promote research activities.



Obstetrics & Gynecology

INTRODUCTION

The Obstetrics and Gynecology Department of Liaquat National Hospital accepts all kinds of obstetrical and gynecological emergencies. The department operates on round the clock basis. Its clinical faculty consists of six full time consultants, three Part-time consultants and three postgraduate senior registrars.

All patient care locations are equipped with modern maternal and fetal monitoring facilities. Approximately 1800 to 2000 deliveries are conducted annually along with the outpatient workload of 25000 to 30,000 patients per year.

Sub-specialties of the department include sub fertility, endoscopic surgery, urogynaecology and gynecological oncology.

UNDERGRADUATE TEACHING

Undergraduate teaching is in the form of lectures, tutorials, small group clinical discussion of 3rd year, 4th year & 5th year as per guidelines of PM&DC. Regular assessments of all 3 clinical years are done at the end of posting by theory examination, clinical examination & OSCIE / OSPE. Undergraduate students keep records in log books, log cards, journal & grade book, and participate in small research projects.

RESEARCH

The Department is also active in research & publications. We have collaborated with two international studies with London School of Hygienic and Tropical Medicine (UK) on “Woman Trial” for Postpartum Hemorrhage. Trial results are now published in Lancet (April, 2017 issue), CORONIS trial results also published in Lancet. More than eight synopses approved and studies are ongoing in the department.

ACHIEVEMENTS

Oncology

INTRODUCTION

The Oncology Department is a dynamic department where solid and hematological malignancies are treated. The department is equipped with state of the art technology. The department consists of skilful and proficient personnel who are striving to provide quality care to the patients. It provides effective and quality training to undergraduate students and post graduate trainees. Medicine residents, interns and medical students do rotations in Oncology as part of their training programme.

SERVICES

The Department of Oncology provides services for cancer management to all disciplines of medicine, surgery, gynecology, pediatrics, nephrology, urology and dermatology. Department consists of a private ward, a general ward and a day-care unit that provides facilities for patients on chemotherapy. Department staff comprises of oncology consultants, senior registrars, registrar, residents and professional nursing staff who is specifically trained to take care of cancer patients. The department provides daily out-patient clinics where patients with newly diagnosed cancers of different body parts are facilitated. Here patients are offered avant- garde treatment including chemotherapy, targeted therapy and immunotherapy. Follow-ups of such patients are also carried out. Moreover, cancer patients who have completed their treatment are also attended to at regular intervals in follow-up.

Tumor Board Meetings are conducted regularly by the department where multi-disciplinary teams discuss difficult cases of cancer and treatment plans are finalized. The department also conducts specialized tumor boards that include weekly breast cancer meetings where all newly diagnosed breast cancers as well as complicated cases are discussed. The best possible management plans are devised during these meetings for the patients.

The department also conducts weekly gynecologic oncology tumor board meetings to provide optimal care to patients with gynecologic malignancies.

A monthly lymphoma meeting is organized to optimize the care of lymphoma patients. All these meetings provide ample opportunities for learning of students and postgraduate doctors and a platform for CME of practicing doctors.

TEACHING

The Department offers an active training programme and provides excellent opportunities for trainees.

At Liaquat National Hospital, regular CME activities are arranged by the department to educate young doctors about the new changes and changing paradigm in cancer treatment.

RESEARCH

The Department is involved in research regarding new treatment and epidemiology of cancers. It encourages students to do the same and undertake publications in peer reviewed journals. Liaquat National Journal of Cancer Care (LNJCC) is a biannual (June & December), peer reviewed open access publication of the department integrating scientific information regarding all oncological specialties from Pakistan and worldwide. It is one of the very few journals published in Pakistan that incorporate oncological manuscripts, case series and review articles. This journal is soon going to be recognized by the HEC department too.



Ophthalmology (EYE)

INTRODUCTION

Liaquat National Hospital is a leading tertiary care hospital in Karachi & the eye department is providing tertiary care services to its patients.

We have 10 fully trained & qualified consultants who are highly acclaimed glaucoma experts, cornea specialists, retina specialists, Paediatric ophthalmologists, refractive surgeons & oculoplastic surgeons, thus all sub-specialties of eye have been covered

We utilize modern tools and carry out advanced tests to accurately diagnose and manage a wide array of eye conditions ranging from dry eye, squint, cataracts, and glaucoma to various retinopathies.

We have excellent facilities for cataract surgeries & we use all types of IOL such as monofocal, multifocal, Trifocals. & Toric lenses.

We also provide round the clock emergency cover for all ophthalmological emergencies such as ocular trauma, foreign body removal, blast injuries and red eye.

Being a part of a multidisciplinary tertiary care set up, the Department of Ophthalmology works in close collaboration with Neurosurgery, Maxillofacial surgery, ENT and Plastic surgery to give our patients comprehensive care.

Top of the range Operation Theatre with surgical facilities for all advanced Cataract, Glaucoma, Retina and Squint.

UNDERGRADUATE TEACHING

We have established undergraduate teaching program since 2006 when LNH medical college was started. All Consultants are involved in teaching and are not only specialized in their respective fields but also aware of the adult learning principles. Our teaching programs are learning-oriented in which both teachers and students share responsibility in the learning process.

RESEARCH

Our research activities are led by all Consultants involving Residents, Registrars and students. We collaborate with other departments of the Hospital on some research projects using a multidisciplinary approach.

ACHIEVEMENTS

To our credit we have 23 FCPS, 8 FRCS and 14 MCPS postgraduates. We are also recognized for post fellowship in retina.



Orthopedic Surgery

INTRODUCTION

The Department of Orthopedic Surgery at Liaquat National Hospital is recognized nationally and internationally as a center of excellence for Orthopedics. We provide care to thousands of patients from pediatrics to geriatrics age groups. We employ cutting edge technology and most recent advances in a practice to provide state-of-the-art, evidence-based care to our patients.

We have 7 full time faculties with three Professors, one Associate Professor and three Assistant Professors as well as one part time consultant.

SERVICES

The Department of Orthopedic surgery at LNH&MC provides services across the following orthopedic disciplines with fellowship trained surgeons who are masters in their own respective fields.

Paediatric Medicine

INTRODUCTION

The Department of Pediatrics at LNH&MC is primarily dedicated to deliver the quality healthcare to children and to train competent, compassionate and caring doctors through excellence in teaching, patient care and medical research.

SERVICES

The Pediatric Department consist medical & surgical ward, NICU, PICU, medical & surgical HDUs and ER. The services are provided round the clock to a wide variety of patients.

The current Paediatric unit provides a range of sub-specialty services to the patients. Along with general Paediatric other specialized services include:

- Paediatric Cardiology
- Neonatology
- Paediatric Intensive care
- Paediatric Infectious Diseases
- Paediatric Metabolic Diseases
- Paediatric Neurology
- Paediatric Surgery

The Department is supported by an efficient Lab Service and a well-equipped Radiology Department which help in early diagnosis and professional management of patients which is our prime goal.

UNDERGRADUATE / POST GRADUATE TRAININGS

The hospital provides Under & Post graduate training for students in the form of well-structured teaching program. Under graduate Students rotate on scheduled rotations in its state-of- the-art NICU/PICU and specialty clinics for immunizations and detection of life-threatening diseases. Fellowship approved by CPSP in Pediatric Cardiology and Pediatric Intensive care.

RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

Participation in research work is actively in progress by undergraduates and post graduate trainees supervised by faculty members. Several research papers have been published in the journals recognized by PM&DC & HEC.

ACHIEVEMENTS

Department of Paediatric is involved in: CME activities of Pakistan Paediatric Association (PPA), Polio eradication program of Government of Pakistan, acute flaccid paralysis surveillance program of WHO, lactation management program of Government of Pakistan, WHO and UNICEF. LNH is also recognized as a baby friendly hospital. Training of nurses in Pediatric specialties as an ongoing activity. Training of Doctors and nurses in PALS and NRP.



Paediatric Surgery

INTRODUCTION

Liaquat National Hospital and Medical College is one of the oldest hospital of the city built over six decades ago, but Paediatric surgical services started 22 years ago. During this short period of time it developed into one of the most active Paediatric surgical units of the city, not only serving patients from the metropolis but also looking after patients brought in from other parts of the country and from abroad as well.

SERVICES

The Department at present is run by three surgeons. The department has got its own dedicated area for inpatients. Neonates and sick children are looked after in shared neonatal intensive care unit and Paediatric ICUs. On average, 2,000 surgical procedures are performed each year including neonatal surgeries, reconstructive surgeries including urological and gastrointestinal reconstruction, hypospadias and genital reconstruction and management of solid tumors.

UNDERGRADUATE / POSTGRADUATE TEACHING

Paediatric surgical unit also provides training to the medical students and residents in Paediatric surgery.

Teaching sessions for core curriculum and journal clubs are held on a regular basis.

The Department organizes regular workshops and CMEs to help in the training of students and residents of other units of the city. Paediatric Laparoscopic Workshop is a regular yearly fixture which is recognized and accredited by the British Association of Paediatric Endoscopic Surgeons. Besides this workshops and live operations have been done for urogenital repair, and hepatobiliary reconstruction.

Due to the induction of a Paediatric urology specialist, department has now a dedicated paed urology executive clinic once every week on Saturday evening and a dedicated Urodynamic session once a week.

The Department is planning to liaison with units in United Kingdom to provide trainees with further exposure abroad.

RESEARCH

The Department is involved in extensive research activities. It encourages students to do the same and undertake publications in reputable journals.



Plastic & Reconstruction Surgery

INTRODUCTION

Plastic Surgery Department of LNH&MC is among one of the best and the oldest department of the country. It has five full time plastic surgeons in its faculty.

SERVICES

The department provides 24 hours emergency services including emergency care for burns, gunshot, hand injuries, road accidents, bomb blast, facial trauma and other trauma.

The departments deals with all plastic surgical problems including congenital defects, reconstruction in head and neck cancer, lower limb trauma, nerve transfers, diabetic foot and chronic wounds, and all hand problems.

Cosmetic procedures of liposuction, abdominoplasty, facelift, rhinoplasty, otoplasty, blepharoplasty and fat grafting, Botox and filler injections are routinely carried out. The department has also startup Hair Transplant and PRP procedure.

The plastic surgery ward is located on the first floor. The ward is fully air conditioned and has facilities of private, semi private rooms and a well-equipped high dependency unit (HDU) for managing critical patients. There are arrangements in the ward for carrying out dressing of burn patients and trauma patients. Services of ICU are also available if required. It also has access to modern and well equipped operations theatre.

UNDERGRADUATE / POSTGRADUATE TEACHING

The department encourages the undergraduates to attend the consulting clinics in the outpatient department, operation theaters and ward rounds to get familiarized with the various aspects of Plastic Surgery. Besides the undergraduate students of Liaquat National Hospital & Medical College, the Plastic Surgery Department also gets students from various other province & private colleges of the city for clinical attachment of 2-4 weeks duration. The department has a busy postgraduate, teaching program, as well.

ACHIEVEMENTS

The department has a fully accredited training program under the auspices of College of Physicians and Surgeons Pakistan. It is among the most sought after residency program of the country. The residents who have qualified from the department are providing services within the country and abroad. Regular Plastic Surgery programs are organized by the department at local, national and international level. The department regularly conducts research projects and has multiple publications to its credit in both national & international journal.



Psychiatry

INTRODUCTION

Psychiatry is a well-established specialty of medicine. The Department of Psychiatry at LNH is committed to evidence based developments in this area and provide our patients with state of art psychiatric care. The Department is headed by Dr. Iqtidar Taufiq and includes 1 other consultant, Dr. Zaibun Nisa and 3 full time clinical psychologists, along with 5 postgraduate trainees of FCPS.

SERVICES

Services include out-patient clinics, teleclinics, Child and Adolescent Guidance Clinic, Psychological Services (Psychometric Testing, Psychotherapy, IQ Testing), and Executive Counseling Services (Marital Counseling, Family Counseling, Career Counseling), ECT (Electro Convulsing Therapy). Stress management clinic, Drug addiction clinic, postpartum depression clinic and Occupational Therapy clinic). Soon to be added will be rTMS. This is the first of its kind in Karachi.

In-patient Services includes Psychiatric Ward comprising 10 bed in-patient unit with additional patients being admitted in the General, Special and Executive wards. Our main aim is to rehabilitate the patients as early as possible.

UNDERGRADUATE / POSTGRADUATE TEACHING

LNH Psychiatry Department is recognized by the College of Physicians and Surgeons for postgraduate training for FCPS. Undergraduate and postgraduate teaching activities include case conferences, journal club, seminars, Undergraduate classes and clinical training. Department of Psychiatry also contributes regularly to CME.

RESEARCH

The Department is also actively involved in conducting clinical researches in order to provide better awareness regarding mental health illnesses. Over the last one year, 4 scientific papers were published in PM&DC / HEC recognized journals.



Pulmonology & Critical Care

INTRODUCTION

The Department of Pulmonary Medicine at Liaquat National Hospital, established 43 years ago, has long served patients from all over Pakistan. As a pioneer unit established in the private sector in the city of Karachi, it provides comprehensive diagnostic and therapeutic services for patients with illness that affect the lungs and breathing. Well qualified and trained physicians provide care for a range of common and rare respiratory conditions.

SERVICES

The Department has morning, afternoon and evening clinics.

The Inpatient Unit/Chest Medicine Unit comprises a fully equipped, ICU (isolation beds with –ve pressure), mechanical ventilator and Noninvasive mechanical ventilators (BiPAP & CPAP), HDU and ward with backup of arterial blood gases analyzer and ECG. Bedside diagnostic and therapeutic procedures like Fiber optic bronchoscopy (FOB), Bronchoalveolar Lavage (BAL), central line placement, bedside ultrasound and ECHO cardiogram are performed as required. Ancillary Services include:

- Limited Sleep Study
- Pulmonary function testing
- Bedside fiber optic bronchoscopy
- Transthoracic needle aspirations
- Chest tube insertions and pleurodesis
- Pleural biopsy

UNDERGRADUATE TEACHING

Students of third, fourth and final year rotate in the department and are provided extensive bedside teaching.

RESEARCH

The Department is involved in research activities. It encourages students to publish research articles in peer reviewed journals.



Radiology

INTRODUCTION

The Department of Radiology and Imaging is at the forefront of innovation and advancement providing premium quality imaging services to the patients.

SERVICES

The Department pioneered the era of high tech imaging by being the first hospital in the country to introduce CT imaging in the year 1984. Now the department has two CT multi- slice scanners (32 and 128 slicers), two 1.5 Tesla MR Scanners, Mammography and bi-planner Angiography

- The Radiology department offers a wide range of non-invasive and interventional radiological services.
- X-Rays, All kind of plain x-rays, fluoroscopy and contrast studies.
- DEXA Scan. (for bone density)
- Ultrasound, All kinds of ultrasounds including whole Body Doppler scans.
- CT scan along with CT Angiography.
- MRI along with MR Angiography and MR spectroscopy.
- Vascular and interventional radiology including angiography and angio- guided embolization.
- Ultrasound and CT guided procedures including all kind of biopsies and drainage procedures.
- Breast interventions including breast and axillary biopsies and interventional clipping.
- Nuclear Medicine tests.
- Radio frequency ablation to treat tumors.
- Stroke Imaging and its management.

UNDER & POST GRADUATE TEACHING AND TRAINING

The Department has a regular training and teaching programme for undergraduate students and postgraduate trainees. It is actively involved in workshops such as hands on training on Carotid Doppler ultrasound and ultrasound guided interventions.

RESEARCH

Faculty and residents participate actively in paper presentations and the department inculcates the importance of research in students and trainees.



Research & Skills Development Centre

INTRODUCTION

Pioneer lab in Pakistan to provide simulation based learning facility for undergraduate as well as post graduate candidates, headed by the first ever certified Regional Faculty of American Heart Association in Pakistan.

SERVICES (AVAILABLE COURSES AND SIMULATORS)

Equipped with a multitude of resources to provide high quality of trainings including; American Heart Association (AHA) accredited Basic Life Support and Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support, Heart Saver First Aid, Advanced Airway Management, Basic Interpretation of ECG, Emergency Response Skills, Basic Surgical Skills and Basic Nursing Skills and many more.

Amongst a wide variety of simulators the few are Mannequins of; Advance Life Support (Kelly), Pediatric Advance Life Support and Neonatal Resuscitation Program, Lumbar Puncture and Advanced Life Support in Obstetrics.

State of the art wet Lab and the Laparoscopic Trainers and Temporal Bone Lab.

UNDERGRADUATE TRAININGS:

The integrated curriculum of undergraduate involves hand hygiene skill, assessment of vital signs, intravenous and Intra-muscular injection technique and many others.

Simulation based clinical scenarios are safely and ethically enacted as part of trainee assessment in OSCE.

RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

A Neonatal Resuscitation Program was run at RSDC recently and a research was conducted on INTERPROFESSIONAL LEARNING EXPERIENCE in collaboration with DHCE.

ACHIEVEMENTS

Established in 1996 as the country's pioneer Skills Lab, the Research and Skills Development Centre (RSDC) at Liaquat National Hospital has steadily evolved into an independent and esteemed learning facility. After expansion in 2012 the Research and Skills Development Centre collaborates with external institutes and organizations through a dedicated full-time team of certified instructor and stands as a beacon of lifesaving expertise, empowering individuals with critical knowledge and clinical skills to make a significant impact in the medical field not only for undergraduate curriculum as well as for post graduate professional development but also for non-health care skills development. In 2017, the center achieved a remarkable feat by earning accreditation from the prestigious American Heart Association (AHA), becoming their International Training Centre. Furthermore, the Centre proudly holds individual certification by ISO 9001-2015. RSDC is comprised of simulated operation theatre, wet lab, tissue lab, computer lab and learning/convening spaces and includes the following facilities like Well-Equipped Training Facilities, Spacious and Interactive Classrooms, Computer Lab with Accessory Setup, Simulated Operation, Practical Tissue Lab and Multiple Basic and Advance Mannequins. The Centre diligently

adheres to international standards and continually researches and updates its training methodologies to remain at the forefront of knowledge.



Rheumatology

INTRODUCTION

The Department of Rheumatology at LNH provides patients with the state of art care according to international guidelines. Our faculty comprises of 3 well-qualified and experienced Rheumatologists.

SERVICES

Our general, subspecialty clinics and inpatients service is catering to more than 25,000 patients per year. We are the only unit in Sindh that has got separate Paeds Rheumatology Clinic and senior citizens clinic. Also, the only institute in Pakistan that runs crystal identification lab in our own department. The Department has a dedicated procedure room for intra-articular soft tissue injections with zero percent infection rate, as per our record.

UNDERGRADUATE TEACHING / TRAINING / MENTORSHIP

We are actively involved in the teaching of our undergraduate students through regular lectures and bedside classes. Undergraduate are also involved in many research projects which are highly appreciated by our peers. We have separate, individual sessions for mentorship of the students.

RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

Several articles have been published in peer reviewed journals and a lot more are on various stages of completion. Our trainees have presented research papers at national as well as international conferences.

ACHIEVEMENTS

We have the honor of being the first unit of Rheumatology in Sindh which is accredited by CPSP for post fellowship training program. Few of our trainee are now supervisors and running post-graduate training/fellowship programs at their centers, some are serving abroad and making us proud with their achievements.

We are proud and pleased to state that our department is excelling day in day out but there are still more avenues to explore and this journey is therefore on our enthusiastic team will make it a world class Rheumatology unit, Insha Allah Taala.!



Thoracic Surgery

INTRODUCTION

The Department offers a very high standard of diagnostic and therapeutic facilities. It is recognized as one of the premier centers for treatment of Thoracic surgery diseases and ailments in the city. All types of adult and pediatric Thoracic surgery procedures are performed here. The department has performed a large number of complicated and complex chest operations. On an average over 500 procedures are performed annually.

SERVICES

In addition onsite, laboratory, blood bank, CT scanning, MRI, Carotid Doppler, Dialysis, Ultrasound, Pulmonary function test, diabetic care and physiotherapy services round the clock which not only saves the patient and their families from running around but at the same time speaks of the multi specialization structure of the hospital and make this unit a very safe place for all types of Thoracic Surgery procedures. All types of Pulmonary and Oesophageal surgery including minimally invasive surgery of lung (VATS) and Oesophagus is performed here and diagnostic procedures like Bronchoscopy and Mediastinoscopy.

UNDERGRADUATE AND POSTGRADUATE TEACHING

The department is recognized for training by the College of Physician and Surgeons Pakistan (CPSP) for FCPS in Thoracic Surgery. The students of LNMC rotate through this department as well. During their stay along with bed side teaching, they are encouraged to attend OT to witness Lung Resection operations and other surgeries like Mediastinoscopy and Video Assisted Thoracoscopic Surgery.

RESEARCH

The department encourages research and has published various papers in PM&DC recognized journals.



Urology

INTRODUCTION

The Department of Urology LNH&MC is one of the leading urological centers of Pakistan and is fully staffed with full-time consultants, part-time consultants, senior registrars, postgraduate residents and Interns.

SERVICES

The Department provides quality surgical and medical care in all specialties of urology including Minimal invasive Surgery, Endoscopic Urology which includes, URS and RIRS. Urological Oncology, Pediatric Urology, Male and Female Genital Re-constructive surgery, Andrology and Day Care Urology.

The Department is equipped with modern technology and skills. There is a well-established urodynamic evaluation facility in the department used for the evaluation and management of patients with BPH, neurogenic bladders, Overactive bladder and incontinence. Day care urological procedures are carried out using flexible fiber optic and rigid endoscopes. The department also has a well-equipped lithotripsy department for stone management.

Laser surgery is also offered and is an excellent mode of treatment for BPH, bladder tumors, Strictures and stones.

Specialized investigations and procedures are also performed for male sexual problems of erectile dysfunction and infertility.

The highly advanced body imaging facilities at LNH&MC assist in accurately evaluating urological problems. More than 2800 urological procedures are undertaken every year by the department and in excess of 25,000 consultations are performed in the outpatient clinic every year.

UNDERGRADUATE TEACHING

The Department offers an active urology training program and provides excellent training facilities for undergraduate students and postgraduate trainees.

RESEARCH

The Department encourages research and publication and is one of the most active departments in this area and provides continuous research opportunities.



Vascular Surgery

INTRODUCTION

Vascular Surgery is a relatively new and rare specialty in our country and the Department of Vascular Surgery at Liaquat National Hospital and Medical College is one of its kinds in the private sector.

The Department is now more than 20 years old and provides a full range of vascular services to the community round the clock. Vascular team comprises of well trained & experienced faculty members, who includes Professor Dr. Kamal M. Yousuf, Assistant professor Dr. S.M. Hammad Alam, and senior registrar Dr. Rabia Gilani, and senior medical officers.

SERVICES

The Department of Vascular Surgery at Liaquat National Hospital provides a variety of experienced and trained Vascular Surgical services, which are available 24/7, most noticeable are as follows:

- Varicose Vein Sclerotherapy
- Varicose Vein Open Surgery
- Treatment of Hemangiomas / Venous/Arterio-Venous Malformations
- Carotid Endarterectomy and Carotid Body Tumor Excision
- Management of Acute Limb Ischemia / Embolectomy
- Surgical management of Diabetic Foot, compartment syndrome
- Management of Vascular Trauma, Firearm & Bomb blast injuries, and Road Traffic Accidents
- Treatment of Abdominal and Peripheral Arterial Aneurysms
- Treatment of Acute and Chronic Arterial Insufficiency
- Arterio-Venous Fistula Creation (also with PTEFE Graft)

UNDERGRADUATE TEACHING

The Department has a comprehensive teaching programme for undergraduate and postgraduate students, keeping in view the needs of our society. The students are exposed to a wide variety of vascular problems and the topics are discussed in form of lectures.

RESEARCH

The Department is actively involved in research activities, geared towards meaningful and scientifically sound publications and we now have around 10 publications on common and rare vascular diseases, in renowned journals. Publications on some recent treatment strategies are in process.

FUTURE PLANS:

With the advancement of technology, Vascular Surgery has also adopted newer ways of treatment which would benefit the society and department in long-run with the aim of minimally invasive but effective treatment for the patients. Therefore, we are starting Radio-frequency ablation (RFA) procedure for Varicose Vein treatment.

Also, we are working towards establishing a fellowship programme in Vascular Surgery which will be recognized by CPSP, and we are hopeful for inducting Vascular Surgery fellows for the year 2023/2024.
